## **Open Campus Lunch Terms and Conditions**

*Students are responsible for their own actions while they are off-campus. The school provides no supervision of off-campus activities and assumes no liability for any accident or injury that occurs while off-campus.*

In order to obtain and retain open campus lunch privileges each student:

- Must be a senior (grade 9-12).
- Must be in good academic, discipline, and attendance standing.
- Must have lunch ID with him/her.
- Students must complete and return parent permission form.
- Is responsible for his/her own transport.
- Must return for the remainder of the day.
- Students must leave within five minutes of when assigned lunch period begins and return before the end of their lunch period. Late(s) / absences will be recorded and affect their final grade. Three tardies to class will result in loss of open campus lunch privileges. Failure to return will be treated as a cut.
- Students may not spend their assigned lunch period in vehicles driving on or around the school campus.
- Students are expected to conduct themselves in a responsible manner and be respectful to homeowners, merchants, and their properties.
- Students are expected to remain in designated areas of the building upon their return from lunch.
- Students may choose to remain at school and use the cafeteria.
- Students are expected to use designated entrances upon exiting and entering the school.
- Students must observe all driving rules and regulations.
- Students may not transport ineligible students off campus. This includes younger students, those who have not turned in permission slips, and those who have been restricted due to disciplinary measures.
- Will be subject to Friday Detention should he/she leave the school without signing out/in.
- Students are expected to follow all school rules while off campus. They are held accountable to these rules.

**Failure to abide by any of the above rules will result in loss of open campus lunch and/or driving privileges for remainder of marking period/semester/ or remainder of the year.**
