How Do I Apply?

- Come tour the school and review the application packet
- Fill out the application forms
- Call to make an appointment for an interview (both parents and students attend)

What Happens at an Interview?

Please bring the following completed forms with you to the interview:

- Student Application
- Legal Residency (Form A or B)
- Student Records Request
- Standard of Conduct
- Enrolment Waiver
- Promissory Agreement

Parents and students will meet with the principal and together we will discuss:

- Who we are and what we offer
- Why you would like to enroll at RPCS
- Your child's educational needs
- How our system works
- Financial arrangements
- Student standard of conduct
- Parent involvement
- Our dress standard
- We will answer your questions

The final decision regarding enrollment will be made based on the needs of both the prospective family and the school.
