



JUNIOR - SENIOR SCHOOL CODE OF CONDUCT

A Christian school is a community of believers working and playing together in an academic and social setting. A school that is identified as Christian demonstrates that a spirit of Christian love prevails in the classrooms, hallways, sports fields, and meeting rooms. We'd like to see that at RPCS. We are called to work, learn, and play in an environment where God is honored and praised and where academic and community responsibilities are encouraged and exercised. Respect for the individuals within the community, respect for the learning environment, and respect for school property are key to creating a Biblical community of learners.

I will honor God by:

- respecting and participating in Bible reading, singing of Christian songs and prayer (such as in Chapel)

I will honor those God has placed in authority over me (teachers, support staff, Principal, parents and coaches) by:

- answering quietly and courteously
- addressing teachers and other staff by their proper title
- respecting non-student areas such as the office, staff and supply rooms, and kitchen
- being in class, ready for instruction at the start of class with required materials
- being respectful to parents and other adults in the school community
- not using cell phones or any electronic game or music player during school hours

I will show respect to those around me by:

- being courteous and speaking kindly, refraining from all teasing and bullying
- not disrupting my class or other classes
- apologizing for wrongdoing
- talking about others only in an encouraging rather than demeaning way
- keeping my hands off others and their property
- driving safely in and around school property (applicable to senior's only)

I will exercise self-discipline by:

- wearing appropriate dress code each day required
- using wholesome language at all times, using the Lord's name appropriately
- refusing to destroy, deface, mutilate or steal school property
- behaving properly in all areas such as the classrooms, hallways, bathrooms, and school grounds (refraining from yelling or rough housing)
- completing and turning in assignments by the due date
- reading and listening to wholesome reading material and music
- staying away from personally and socially destructive activities, including smoking, sexual activity, drinking alcohol, using illegal drugs or participating in illegal activities
