



## ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CODE OF CONDUCT

A Christian school is a place where we will show respect in the classrooms, hallways, gym, playground and chapel. Here at RPCS we work together to make sure that God is honored and praised. You need to do your part to make that happen every day. Respect for the people in the school, respect for classroom order, and respect for school property are keys in creating a safe and Godly school.

### **I will honor God by:**

- respecting and participating in Bible reading, singing Christian songs, and prayer (such as in chapel, class devotions and Bible class)

### **I will honor teachers, support staff, Principal, parents, student helpers and coaches by:**

- answering quietly and courteously
- using teachers and other staff members' proper title (Mr., Mrs., Miss)
- being in class, ready to start at the beginning of class with everything I need
- being respectful to all adults who are in the school
- not bringing cell phones or any electronic game or music players or toys to school

### **I will show respect to those around me by:**

- being kind and polite, not disrupting my class or other classes (quiet in the hall)
- talking nicely to or about others, no teasing or bullying
- speaking kindly and quietly
- apologizing for doing things wrong
- keeping my hands off others and their property (no pushing, kicking, fighting)

### **I will practice self-control by:**

- wearing all of the uniform, including dress shoes, when I'm supposed to
- using clean language at all times, no swearing or using God's name incorrectly
- not destroying, carving on, drawing on or stealing school property
- behaving properly in all areas such as the classrooms, hallways, bathrooms, and school grounds (no yelling, fooling around or making a mess)
- finishing assignments and homework on time
- reading and listening to clean reading material and music
- staying away from unclean movies, internet sites, TV or music with a bad message

I understand the student Code of Conduct. I know that if I break any of these, I will earn a detention or whatever the Principal assigns and may be asked to withdraw from the school.
